**Matthew 5:43 - 48 (NLT)** <sup>43</sup>“You have heard that the law of Moses says, ‘Love your neighbor’ and hate your enemy. <sup>44</sup>But I say, love your enemies! Pray for those who persecute you! <sup>45</sup>In that way, you will be acting as true children of your Father in heaven. For he gives his sunlight to both the evil and the good, and he sends rain on the just and on the unjust, too. <sup>46</sup>If you love only those who love you, what good is that? Even corrupt tax collectors do that much. <sup>47</sup>If you are kind only to your friends, how are you different from anyone else? Even pagans do that. <sup>48</sup>But you are to be perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect.

### The Dangers of Living this Out

That I live my life in a Holy \_\_\_\_\_

**Matthew 5:14 - 16 (NCV)** <sup>14</sup>“You are the light that gives light to the world. A city that is built on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup>And people don't hide a light under a bowl. They put it on a lampstand so the light shines for all the people in the house. <sup>16</sup>In the same way, you should be a light for other people. Live so that they will see the good things you do and will praise your Father in heaven.

That I get \_\_\_\_\_ into a life of sin myself

**Romans 7:14 -15, 21-23 (NLT)** <sup>14</sup>The law is good, then. The trouble is not with the law but with me, because I am sold into slavery, with sin as my master. <sup>15</sup>I don't understand myself at all, for I really want to do what is right, but I don't do it. Instead, I do the very thing I hate... <sup>21</sup>It seems to be a fact of life that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. <sup>22</sup>I love God's law with all my heart. <sup>23</sup>But there is another law at work within me that is at war with my mind. This law wins the fight and makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me.
