Romans 10:1-4 (NLT, pg. 942)

It is possible to have a strong enthusiasm for God and not be _____.

Romans 10:3 (NLT) For they don't understand God's way of making people right with himself. Refusing to accept God's way, they cling to their own way of getting right with God by trying to keep the law.

Romans 10:5-21 (NLT, pg. 943)

Romans Road to salvation:

Romans 3:23 (NLT, pg. 937) For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

Romans 6:23 (NLT, pg. 939) For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:6,8 (NLT, pg. 938) When we were utterly helpless, Christ came at just the right time and died for us sinners... But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.

Romans 10:9,13 (NLT, pg. 943) If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved... For "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Romans 10:14 (NLT) But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them?

Romans 10:15 (NLT) And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, "How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!"

Matthew 28:18-20 (NLT, pg. 828) Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Final Thought: _____ (NLT, pg. 896) Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

Romans 10 Discussion Questions

"It is possible to have a strong enthusiasm for God and not be saved." How does this statement make you feel? Explain. Have you prayed and invited Jesus into your life to forgive and save you? If not, what is holding you back? If so, share your experience with your group. How has your life changed since you became a Christian? Would you be

willing to share your story on video or in a celebration Sunday service?

When is the last time you shared your faith or presented the gospel message to someone? Do you do this regularly? If so, how does it typically go? If not, what is keeping you from doing it? Explain. Review the Romans Road to salvation (3:23, 6:23, 5:6,8, 10:9,13). Is this method of explaining the gospel simple and clear for you? Why or why not? What other methods have you seen and/or used to communicate the gospel message?

What is your view of “organized religion”? Do you think there is a difference between organized religion and churches that have an organized structure of leadership? Why or why not? Read Mark 7:5-8 and Matthew 9:36-38. Based on these passages, how do you think Jesus would answer the previous question? Read Acts 6:1-7. How is this organization of the early church different than what the Pharisees did? Explain.
